From an Olympic-themed drumming session with 200 drummers and 400 drumsticks in a corporate setting, to creating and performing new music with Unaccompanied Asylum–Seeking Children, to individually focussed sessions with some truly remarkable disabled young people; I will be drawing on the wide variety of programmes I have designed and delivered over the years, to help shape the future programme at More Music.

It's very apparent that More Music is an incredibly valued organisation; an asset to Morecambe and a much-loved venue for gigs and for local people to make music together.

I hope you'll pop along to an event or a workshop, by yourself, with your friends and family, a school or community group, especially if you've never visited before – I very much look forward to meeting you!

Mavericks, inventors, virtuosi. Stevens & Pound brings together BBC Radio 3's award-winning Delia Stevens - a classically trained percussionist - and triple BBC Radio 2 Folk Musician of the Year nominee Will Pound - a trad folk harmonica and melodeon player.
